CERAMIC SHOW

RULES

- This is a ceramic art exhibition. Polymer clay is NOT ceramic clay. Paper clay is allowed. Ceramic work must consist of at least 75% ceramic clay.
- Mixed media ceramic work is allowed as long as 75% of the overall piece is ceramic clay
- Must be 18 years or older to participate
- Must be a registered and current Oregon Potters Association (OPA) member
- Ceramic work must have been produced in the last five years
- Functional, Non-Functional, and Sculptural work is accepted
- Ceramic artists can submit up to 3 ceramic pieces with registration fee
- No refunds or late entries will be accepted.
- All submitted work must include an explanation, 300 words or less, explaining why it fulfills the theme, 'Artists Have Voice'
- Ceramic pieces not in compliance with the rules will not be accepted.

ARTWORK SIZE, WEIGHT, AND HANGERS

- Ceramic work must be show ready, either standing, hanging, or with artist jewelry display when delivered on May 28th-May 31st
- Maximum size of artwork is not to exceed 90 inches on any side
- Minimum size of artwork is 2 inches tall on any side. Jewelry is measured by the

display it rests on.

- Ceramic work must not exceed 50 lbs for standing weight
- Ceramic work must not exceed 25 lbs for hanging weight.
- Hanging work should have hanging wire firmly attached. If other hanging materials are required, like a french cleat or similar, you will need to contact galleries@chehalemculturalcenter.org to confirm allowance.
- The Chehalem Cultural Center Galleries Coordinator has the right to ask the artist to assist in the hanging and/or displaying of any ceramic piece

ART SALES / COMMISSION

All ceramic work must be for sale and realistically priced. The Chehalem Cultural Center will send a check within 90 days of the end of the ceramic show. Ceramic work sales will be conducted by Chehalem Cultural Center staff only. Artists are not allowed to negotiate prices with buyers, and any similar work listed elsewhere by artists should match the price of work at the Chehalem Cultural Center.

The Chehalem Cultural Center will retain a commission of 40% to assist in covering show costs.
